These awards are open to any USA-UK registered horse, owned by a USA-UK member.

POINTS FOR IN HAND, RIDDEN AND YOUTH HI-POINT AWARDS

CATEGORIES & POINTS:

CATEGORY 1: ENDURANCE (a) pleasure rides and endurance rides up to 50km (30 miles) - 1 point per km. (b) Endurance rides 51-80 km (31 to 50 miles) - 2 points per km. (c) Endurance rides 81km and over (51 miles+) - 3 points per km.

Endurance BONUS POINTS

Grading : 1 = 60 points, 2 = 50 points, 3 = 40 points, 4 = 25 points.

Additional points if placed : 1st = 60 points, 2nd = 50 points, 3rd = 40 points, 4th = 30 points, 5th = 20 points, 6th = 10 points.

(Example, if you complete a 50 mile ride, at Grade 2 and place 4th overall, you will score 160 points, with a bonus of 80 (50 + 30), given you 240 points for that ride).

Points for categories 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 are shown in the table below.

CATEGORY 2. Hunter Trials, One Day Event, 3 Day Eventing, Point to Point.

CATEGORY 3. BHS, BD or BSJA Affiliated - Combined Training, Dressage, Show Jumping. ISSEA-GB Affiliated Equitation.

CATEGORY 4. Ridden & In Hand Showing (includes all Saddlebred classes), Hack, Riding Horse, Road Hack, Hunter, Hunter Hack, Youngstock, Working Hunter, Riding Club Horse, Sports Horse, Best Skewbald/Piebald, Western Pleasure, Western Riding etc. plus any non-affiliated class listed in category 3. Excludes any class listed in category 5.

CATEGORY 5. Utility Showing - C&T, Best Rider, Veterans, Family Mount, Best Colour Markings, Western Trail, Showmanship, Concours D'Elegance, Horsemanship etc.

CATEGORY 6. Gymkhana's, Handy Mount, Child Handler, Novelty Classes. (Category 6 points can only be awarded to Youth Members - Youths can earn points in categories 1 to 6). In addition, Youth members can earn points for every USA-UK run competition (e.g. colouring competition, newsletter quiz etc.)

+ 40 points (any class) Includes our Championship Show, BSPA World Championship of Colour & Spring Festival, CHAPS Championship Show, Royal London Show, WES Championship show etc.

Saddlebred only Classes (classes not open to other breeds)

+ 50 points (E.g. In Hand, 3-G, 5-G, Western and Hunter)

American only breeds (in hand, hunter, western, saddle seat pleasure) + 20 points

Foreign Breeds (in hand & ridden) + 10 points

Please remember:

- Once your horse is registered with us he/she is registered for life. Your horse can start earning points once he/she is registered with us.
- Owners and exhibitors must be current USA-UK members before any points your horse has earned can be included – if you join in January, your horse cannot earn points prior to you being a member (e.g. you cannot include shows in December).
- The season runs from 1st October (2008) to 30th September (2009).
- Completed hi-point books should be returned by 10th October and the correct remittance included (made payable to USA-UK please).
- Do not forget to tick if you are competing in any of the State Pleasure Awards (tick as many that your horse is eligible for), KC Futurity, Versatility, Members Cup and Road Hack Awards. These are free to take part in (once you have entered the in hand and/or ridden section of the hi-points), but you need to (1) tick the boxes on the front of the hi-point book (2) fill in the relevant page inside the hi-point book (this will probably mean duplicating some of the results that you have entered for the in hand and/or ridden sections).

- Celebrate the American Saddlebred Horse and work towards Championship status by taking part in these annual hi-point and SASH Awards (Show Awards for Saddlebred Horses).
- SASH Awards are made to each horse on the accumulation of points – 1,000 points equates to Bronze level, 2,500 points to Silver level and 5,000 points Gold level and allocation of “CHAMPION” status. Platinum level is gained upon reaching 10,000 points and Solar level upon reaching 20,000 points. Points will be deemed gained upon return of Hi-Points Book each year.
- Horse must be registered with USA-UK and owned by a USA-UK member in order for points to be eligible. Points are accumulative and can be earned throughout a horse’s lifetime.
- Bronze – 1,000 points – certificate awarded.
- Silver – 2,500 points – certificate awarded.
- Gold – 5,000 points – certificate awarded, presentation of SASH Award and prefix “CH” added to horses name.
- Platinum – 10,000 points – certificate and trophy presented.
- Solar – 20,000 points – certificate and embroidered rug presented.
