the efforts of the United Saddlebred Association. In addition many shows offer Foreign Breed classes where our fabulous members' rosettes can be won.

Don't forget to take part in our Year End Awards – there are a whole host of them, from awards for youngstock to awards for versatility as well as awards for members that promote the breed and those that simply enjoy hacking on their Saddlebred. Whatever members do with their Saddlebreds, the United Saddlebred Association is proud to acknowledge. Once the SASH Awards stopped at 5,000 points and your horse was awarded his/her championship status. Now they continue – the Platinum Award at 10,000 points and the Solar Award at 20,000 points.
