There are four positions that have expired terms. The BOD will elect the officers immediately following the Annual Meeting.

ASAM Announces 2008 Horse Show Dates

The American Saddlebred Association of Maine announced their 2008 horse show dates. The ASAM season kicks off on Sunday, April 27, 2008 at the Hollis Equestrian Park with the Long Horn Fun Festival Horse Show. The show is in its third year and will offer MHA points this year as a D rated MHA show. This show remains unique, even as a MHA affiliated show, by offering a day pass for exhibitors. The ASAM Spring Show will follow just three weekends later on Saturday, May 17 at the Hollis Equestrian Park. This show is a double-judged, double-pointed show for all exhibitors. ASAM's crown jewel, the 34th Annual Summer Show, will be held July 18, 19 & 20, 2008 at the Skowhegan Fairgrounds. ASAM also has plans for a Fall Fuzzy Fun Show and Trail Ride in October of 2008 but has not secured a date at this time.
