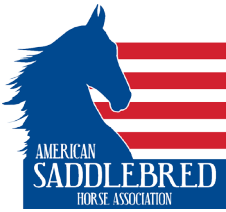

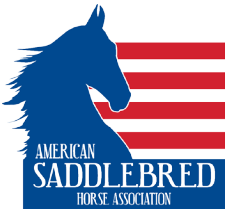

These are just some of the benefits of your membership with the ASHA!

- 1. ASHA Website. www.saddlebred.com**

The center for all information about American Saddlebreds, from general information, to the latest news coverage, show records, member directory, stable and business directory, award winners, magazine archives, stallion reference directory, board and committee information and minutes, information on the history of the American Saddlebred, videos, promotional brochures, show calendar, high point leaderboard, upcoming show calendar.
- 2. ASHA Online Services**

ASHA online services give members a place online to renew memberships, do pedigree research on registered American Saddlebreds, purchase DVDs, posters, and view competition records, search horse and member records. Log in with a user name and password for members, or non-members may purchase a temporary day pass for \$10.
- 3. Journal of the American Saddlebred**

This four color printed journal, is the most comprehensive publication on American Saddlebred breeding stock around. Active stallions are featured with formatted pages showing their successes in the showing and the success of their get. Stallion rankings, broodmare sire information, geographical index, and general sire list are also included. Historical articles on famous stallions and influential Saddlebred breeders are featured. A keepsake reference book that no serious breeder should be without.
- 4. Special Awards for Special Individuals**

From recognizing the contributions of important members to their association, to recognizing breeders who have had winners at the Kentucky State Fair, the ASHA has a number of special awards which annually honor their best and finest. Most are recognized at the annual ASHA Convention.
- 5. Showing Privileges in USEF Recognized Shows**

ASHA Competing Members are eligible to show at all USEF recognized shows with classes for American Saddlebreds.
- 6. High Point and Sport Horse Programs**

ASHA Competing Members can participate in a variety of High Point programs both at the national level and the state level through their local charter clubs, including a variety of special Pleasure Awards. American Saddlebred and Half-Saddlebred Sport Horses competing in open dressage, combined driving, endurance riding, eventing, and Pony Club activities are also eligible for recognition and prizes.
- 7. Prize Programs**

The American Saddlebred Registry (ASR) sponsors lucrative Sweepstakes and Futurity prize programs, for which members may nominate their horses. Many states also offer state or regional Sweepstakes and Futurities.
- 8. Charter Clubs and Youth Clubs**

ASHA members can participate at the regional or local level in over 40 Charter Clubs and Youth Clubs throughout the US and abroad. Charter and Youth Clubs put on regional shows, and help organize local events for American Saddlebreds such as trail rides, camps, parades, and horse fairs.
- 9. Special Junior Awards & Programs**

Youth members can compete for awards in the Academy division as well as keeping track of their riding time in the "Saddle Time" program, which awards bronze, silver, and gold medals for participation. Other awards include Showmanship Halter, Photo Contests and the ASHA Youth Award. Junior members may also participate in Junior Judging competitions at selected shows.
- 10. Youth Scholarships**

ASHA annually awards a number of \$5,000 scholarships to its youth members. Members must apply and provide an academic transcript.
- 11. Annual Convention & Youth Conference**

Held annually, the ASHA Annual Convention features committee meetings, awards presentations, educational speakers, and the ASHA Year End Awards Presentations. A fun weekend of socializing and fun with other Saddlebred enthusiasts. A special Youth Conference includes a field trip to local Saddlebred destinations, Saddlebred Gala and other entertainment.
- 12. Kentucky State Fair/ World's Championship Horse Show**

The ASHA is proud to be the co-promoter of the World's Championship Horse Show at the KY State Fair in late August of each year. The ASHA staff assembles a daily magazine with the previous days' results and judge's cards, which many view as collector's items. A full slate of fun youth programs are offered, including Junior Judging, Saddlebred Bingo at the Fair, and Golf Cart Decorating Contest. A popular feature is the recognition of all "First Timers" each year with a presentation at center ring of special commemorative ribbons.
- 13. Special prices on services with the American Saddlebred Registry**

ASHA members are entitled to do business with the American Saddlebred Registry. Non-members must pay a non-member fee per transaction.
